

# VACANCY

The College of Transfiguration NPC has a vacancy for the following academic post:

## LECTURER IN PRACTICAL THEOLOGY

To commence on 1<sup>st</sup> February 2018.

The College of Transfiguration NPC is based in Grahamstown and is provisionally registered as a higher education institution in terms of the Higher Education Act, 1997. It is a registered non-profit company in terms of the Companies Act, 2008. The College offers accredited qualifications for the Diploma in Theology and the Bachelor of Theology. The College of Transfiguration NPC is a provincial institution for the training and formation of Anglican clergy. Its mission is to graduate ministers of the church that could serve as agents of change in church and society. The College utilizes theological learning tools that are "interdisciplinary, contextual and critical, anchored in the Anglican tradition and ethos.

### Duties and responsibilities:

- All academic staff is responsible for teaching and learning, course design, student support, assessment design and administration.
- The College is a residential seminary and academic staff is expected to take part in all aspects of community life.
- All academic staff plays a role in the spiritual formation of the ordinands, and contributes to the shaping of the community in every manner possible.
- The role of lecturer in practical theology will include teaching and facilitating courses in, but not limited to, Christian spirituality, pastoral care, spiritual direction and individual & group counselling, however all lecturers at the College of Transfiguration are required to occasionally pick up areas of teaching as requested by the Rector.

### Minimum Requirements:

- A PhD in Practical Theology.
- A Master's degree in Practical Theology or in Pastoral Studies and Counselling, with progress being made towards a PhD, will be considered
- An ordained priest in the Anglican Communion or in any of the CUC churches in South Africa
- A record of verifiable publications in peer-reviewed journals, and/or experience in teaching theology at higher education, and/or as a parish priest.
